VENDOR CONTRACT

Artist hereby makes application to exhibit at the Slidell Art Market.
Payment in full required with contract.

1. Cost:

Vendor participation fee guarantees one approximately 10 x 10 foot space of ground only in the Slidell Art Market. Exhibitors may share a space with approval from the Slidell Art League market manager (up to two artists).

2. Spaces:

Exhibition spaces will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. We will try to accommodate requests if they are made in a timely manner. No changes regarding the location of a space can be made the day of the day of the Market. Booth numbers will be emailed to vendors prior to the market. Spaces may be limited due to the popularity of the market.

3. Booth Set Up:

Each exhibitor agrees to supply his own tent, tables, chairs, umbrella or whatever furnishings he/she requires for display. Please consider the space restrictions and make sure that your set up fits into a 10 x 10 footprint and will not infringe on another exhibitors space. Electricity will not be available. White tents are strongly preferred.

4. Clean Up:

The exhibitor(s) in a space at the Market agrees to maintain the cleanliness of his/her space during the Market and to remove any trash which has accumulated at the end of the Market. Failure to do so will be considered unfavorable to future participation in the Market.

5. Insurance:

SAL's Art Market provides no liability or property insurance. Each exhibitor is responsible for his/her own coverage and by signing this contract, participant relieves Slidell Art League, its Officers, Directors, and members of any responsibility for the safety of participant's person or property while at the market.

6. Cancellation of a scheduled Market by Slidell Art League:

Should any event arise which prevents the organizing body to hold a scheduled Market, the contract is void and the exhibitor waives the right to make any claim for damages other than the return of the vendor fee. SAL reserves the right to cancel the market due to lack of participation. A minimum of eight (8) vendor booths is required for a market.

7. Deadlines:

Payment in full of the vendor fee must be received by the Slidell Art League no later than 11 a.m. on the Friday prior to the Saturday Art Market taking place. No confirmations are sent other than assigned booth numbers. You will be contacted only if there is a problem with your registration.

8. Set up/Tear down Times:

Set up of your booth will take place between 7 a.m. and 8 a.m. on the day of the Market only. The Market is held on a street which will not be barricaded until the morning of the Market, so you may not leave any part of your booth set up the night before. Your booth must be completely set up by the start of the Market at 8:30 a.m. After the closure of the Market, your booth must be completely disassembled and removed from the premises by 3:30 p.m. at which

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time the street will be reopened to car traffic. Failure to complete your set up and/or tear down in a timely manner will be considered unfavorable for future participation.

9. Market Hours and Location:

The Art @ The Market will be held the first Saturday of each month, 8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (in conjunction with the Farmers' Market). Location is on Second Street in Olde Towne next to the Camellia City Farmer's Market. All exhibitors agree to stay the entire duration of the Market.

10. Management of the Market reserves the right to reject any contract for exhibit space. No one contract guarantees the right to future contracts for future Markets. Once you have participated in the SAL's Market, future contracts are contingent on: sustained quality of work, timely payment of vendor fee, reliability and appropriate conduct at the Market.

11. Sales Tax:

All vendors are responsible for their own sales, credit card machines, payment of their own sales tax, etc. Each vendor is considered his own company and must pay sales tax under his own E.I.N. (Federal Tax ID Number) or social security number. The Slidell Art League will not keep track of your sales or the amount of tax you collect and therefore owe. SAL takes no commission.

12. Request for Removal of Items for Sale:

The Art Market Manager/Management of the Slidell Art League's Art Market reserves the right to demand removal of any items for sale at a vendors booth which it deems inappropriate for the following reasons: It is not reflective of original and unique artwork and/or it does not fall under the category of fine arts (i.e. brownies, lemonade, t-shirts, etc).

13. Refund of Vendor Fees:

A refund of a vendor fee will be made only if written cancellation is received two full weeks prior to the Art Market. Once a contract has been made, cancellation for reasons other than health or emergency will not be looked upon favorably nor permitted.

14. Rain Policy:

The SAL Art Market is an outdoor market which will be held "rain or shine" except in the case of severe weather. If a market is going to be cancelled, you will be contacted via email the night before the event and your vendor fee will be rolled over to the next scheduled Market. No refunds of vendor fees will be made as a result of cancellation due to weather or natural disaster. Note: If a market is cancelled you MAY NOT set up your tent independently. Participant expressly agrees to indemnify and hold harmless, the Slidell Art League, its officers and employees, its successors or assigns, against all suits, actions, demands or damages that arise from participation in the said art market on the date specified. Your signature below also serves as consent to use any photos taken during your participation for promotional purposes.
