

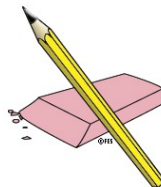

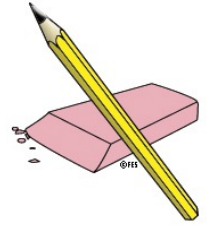

Supply List for Pencil Portraits with Charlie Webb

1- **Sheet** Strathmore Drawing Paper at least 70 lb but preferably 100 lb

8 - **Pencils** (two each - they come in packs of two)

- B
- B2
- B4
- B8 or B9

Erasers

- 8 - Pencil tip erasers (the kind that goes on the end of the pencil)
- 1 - Pink Pearl eraser

1 - **Pencil sharpener**

1 - **Set of shading stumps** (get the assorted pack with large and small stumps)

Several sheets of **tissue** paper (like Kleenex)

Bring a copy of an 8 x 10 photo, preferably a professional portrait, of a single person that is a head and shoulders shot. It is good to make a black and white copy of it as this will help you with your values.

NOTE: Charlie is a self taught artist and is willing to share what he knows about drawing pencil portraits!
