Begin with the basics of pastels, or build on the skills you've already learned in Jean's previous workshops! Everyone welcome! Bring a picture you would like to paint – NO PORTRAITS, PLEASE. Flowers, animals, Birds, still life or landscapes would do.

**SUPPLY LIST:**

- 1 – Starter set soft pastels. Should be approximately 12 sticks and should state “SOFT”. Should be for general use not specifically for portraits, landscapes, etc.
- 1 – charcoal pencil #6B
- 1 – white charcoal pencil.
- 1 – starter set of Conté or Derwent Pastel Pencils
- Good pencil Sharpener or utility knife with new blade for sharpening pencils
- 1 – sheet either:
  - Pastel Board
  - Artist sanded paper– Preferred (available at Moe's)
  - Pastel paper – this comes in a pack. I would suggest a neutral color
- 1 kneaded eraser
- 1 – old towel for the table
- 1 – roll of paper towels

Most of these supplies can be purchased at Mo's in Covington, Michael's in Mandeville or Hobby Lobby in Slidell.
