Join Larisa as she demonstrates her distinctive style using Russian made St. Petersburg Pan Watercolors. St. Petersburg Pan Watercolors are manufactured in a liquid pour process so pans are rich and creamy.



**About the Artist**

Larisa's discipline extends from water color to oil, wooden icon and etching to mural, interior design to festival posters for Russian festivals and the Tchaikovsky festival. The versatility of her artistic expression is found in landscapes, flowers, nudes, portraiture and religious art.

Major contributions of religious art in New Orleans make her one of the first women to have achieved such in church art. St. Jude Shrine and the chapel of Our Lady of Guadalupe at St. Vincent de Paul are both graced by murals, icons and large oil paintings in her distinctive style. Larisa completed a series of the 14 Stations of the Cross in egg tempera on mahogany wood in the Iconographic style for Blessed Francis X Seelos Catholic Church in New Orleans.

Larisa is currently available for teaching work shops in the New Orleans area.
