Watercolor 101 with Don Edwards



Materials:

Paint: Cobalt Blue, Ultramarine Blue, Cadmium Red Deep, Alizarin
Crimson, Cadmium Yellow, Burnt Umber, Raw Umber, Sap Green, Burnt
Sienna

1 sheet of 140 # Arches cold pressed watercolor paper,
one cut (or torn) into eighths (or 8 sheets size 9 X 7")

2 inch brush, 1 inch brush, ½ inch brush, # 8 , # 6, # 4, # 1, #00 (rigger)

Kneaded eraser

Small natural sponge

2 pencil

Roll of 1"

Painters tape

Board – size 24" X 32" (Can be Masonite, foam core, or 1/4 " plywood that has been
varnished)

Easel if desired

2 water large mouth jars

White plastic watercolor palette(John Pike is the style is best)

Spray bottle with water (use an empty Windex bottle or similar or go to beauty supply
store)

paper towels or box of Kleenex

Small bottle of liquid mask

Toothpicks

Notepad

Indelible black pen
